AWARD CRITERIA

Any individual, family, or group can receive Presidential recognition for volunteer hours earned over a 12-month period or over the course of a lifetime at home or abroad. The following are the eligibility requirements:

	BRONZE	SILVER	GOLD	LIFETIME
Kids: Age 5-14	50 to 74 hours	75 to 99 hours	100 hours or more	4,000 hours or more (over a lifetime)
Young Adults: Individual Age 15-25	100 to 174 hours	175 to 249 hours	250 hours or more	4,000 hours or more (over a lifetime)
Adults: Individual Age 26 +	100 to 249 hours	250 to 499 hours	500 hours or more	4,000 hours or more (over a lifetime)
Family & Groups* (2+people)	200 to 499 hours	500 to 999 hours	1000 hours or more	4,000 hours or more (over a lifetime)

*In families and groups, each member contributing to the total number of hours must have served 25 hours or more.
